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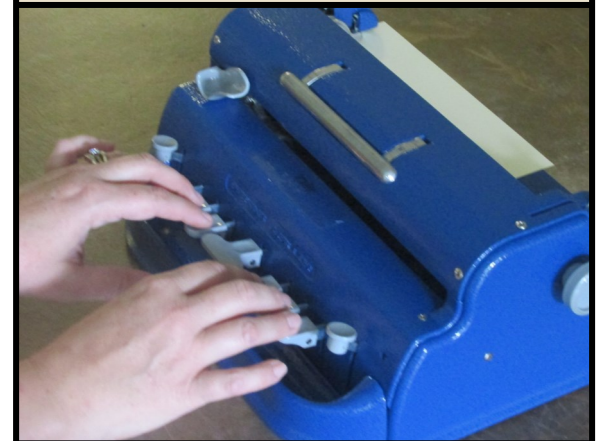

## **Unified English Braille for Vision Professionals**



**An Online Class  
May 29, 2017-  
August 25, 2017**

**Purpose:** To prepare vision professionals for the implementation of Unified English Braille into their teaching and transcribing.

**Class Content:**

The entire UEB code book will be covered in 12 sessions.

Each session consists of a video approximately 30 to 60 minutes in length, optional drill practice and a graded homework assignment of 50 items.

Participants should aim to complete one session a week.

**Objectives:**

- Accurately transcribe representative samples of print text into UEB and UEB into print.
- Cite rule references to demonstrate ability to locate and apply rules.

- Strong foundation in braille
- High-speed Internet access
- Braille translation program Perky Duck, a free download
- Adobe Reader, a free download
- MS Word 2007 or later
