BUILDING BLOCKS TO KNOWLEDGE

CAREER AND COLLEGE READINESS

JULY 8-20

A two-week transition-focused experience for Wisconsin students who are blind or visually impaired ages 14-21.

Students in this program will learn the building blocks necessary to live independently. Classes will include:

- Career and Vocational Education
- Exploring Higher Education
- Independent Living / Personal Management
- Self Advocacy
- Orientation & Mobility
- Social Interaction

Students, under the supervision of staff, may leave campus. There are up to 20 available spots for this program.



INTERMEDIATE LITERACY

JULY 29-AUGUST 3

A one-week literacy-focused experience for Wisconsin students who are blind or visually impaired ages 8-13.

Learning one skill can help build others. In this program, students will learn about independence, working in groups, traveling in unfamiliar areas, cooking, how to integrate technology with every day activities and when and how to ask for assistance.

Students will learn these skills as they write children's books.

Students, under the supervision of staff, may leave campus. There are up to 20 available spots for this program.



BEGINNING LITERACY

JULY 31-AUGUST 3
DAYTIME PROGRAM ONLY

A literacy-focused experience for Wisconsin students who are blind or visually impaired ages 4-7.

This is a **day program** only. Students should arrive at 9 am and be picked up at 3 pm. Daily transportation is the responsibility of the family.

Lunch will be provided.

Activities will include letter recognition, music, reading time, exploration, and motor skills.

Students, under the supervision of staff, may leave campus. There are up to 6 available spots for this program.
